I hereby certify, that this map or survey is one of three similar maps or surveys, caused to be made by the Commissioners of the Central Park, of 155th Street from the Hudson River to the Harlem River, and of 156th Street and 157th Street from the Kingsbridge Road to the Road or public Drive, and of 158th Street from the Kingsbridge Road to the Hudson River, and of 159th Street and 160th Street from the Kingsbridge Road to the 11th Avenue, and of 161st Street from the 10th Avenue to the 11th Avenue, and of the Kingsbridge Road from the north side of 155th Street to the south line of 161st Street, extended in an easterly direction, laid out by said Commissioners, and which maps or surveys are required to be made, certified and filed, by Chap. 565 of the laws of 1865.


